Risk Assessment

This risk assessment is undertaken to comply with our insurance policy.

- Members are reminded that it is their personal responsibility to decide on the level of their capability and whether they should participate in any of the Society's weekend activities.
- The Imperial Hotel has accessible ground-floor entry and a lift to all floors of the main building.
- The public areas of the Hotel (reception, bar, restaurant) are all on the ground floor, as is the meeting room.
- During the walks at Dunkery Beacon and Heddon's Mouth, there is some uneven terrain, so suitable footwear should be worn and care taken.
- The walk at Heddon's Mouth will be alongside deep water, so care should be taken.
- Both walks include crossing public roads, so care should be taken.
- If anyone offers a lift in a private car, they should ensure that they have insurance cover for passengers.
- Any activities engaged upon on the Sunday after the AGM meeting itself are at the Members' own risk and are not covered by the HWS insurance.
