Rules

Prizes:

To the school of the winning entrant - **£500**

To the winner - **£100**

To the two runners-up – **£50** each

Entries: Postal entries only. They must be typed or handwritten in black ink, suitable for photocopying.

Age Range: Years 8 and 9.

Entries are to be clearly marked with pupil's name, date of birth, and name and address of school.

Judging criteria: Work will be judged on originality, imagination, empathy and style (please refer to the competition guidelines).

Winners: Winner and runners-up will be notified through their schools in September 2020. Their entries (names will not be made public) will be published on the Society's website www.henrywilliamson.co.uk, and displayed at the Annual General Meeting of the Henry Williamson Society in October.

Return of entries: Entries can only be returned if accompanied by a stamped addressed envelope, and not before October 2020.
